

New ADA playground law is mandatory as of March 15, 2012. *Here's how to comply.*

Effective March 15, 2012, new and renovated playground surfaces must pass ASTM Standards for impact protection (F 1292) and wheelchair access (F 1951).

Just follow these three simple steps to ensure ADA compliance with your Fibar® Engineered Wood Fiber surface:



1. Place FibarMat Wear Mats under all swings and slides.

ADA FibarMat Wear Mats prevent holes under swings, at slide exits and other high use areas—vital for ADA compliance. Unlike other wear mats, ADA FibarMats have beveled edges for greater accessibility. And they pay for themselves by greatly reducing the need for raking in heavy use areas.



2. Add at least 1 ADA FibarRamp to your surfacing system.

The new law mandates that access to all public playgrounds *must* be provided. ADA FibarRamps provide easy access and exit—even for motorized wheelchairs. And FibarRamps high-density polyethylene construction ensures they won't fade, splinter or crack. The ADA FibarRamp is used in conjunction with the FibarGuard border system.



3. Top-off your surface regularly. Regular **Fibar Top-offs** ensure that your Fibar Engineered Wood Fiber surface is in compliance with the 2012 ADA Law requiring surfaces to pass ASTM F 1292 for impact attenuation.
